Fellow laborers in Christ,



The Lord has given confirmation after confirmation since we first surrendered to go, and it really is very heartening to see it unfold.

While we were there we met the people at Sbor Baptistů, the church that Bro. Jon Rettig planted. There's always a little trepidation when meeting people for the first time, but we felt just as comfortable and at home as we did at Beth Haven Baptist Church. A few of the members don't speak English, but that didn't stop us from thoroughly enjoying all the time we were able to spend with all of them. It was also very encouraging to see that they have a heart to see their neighbors and family reached with the Gospel, and it is apparent. Eternity and I were both able to share our testimonies with the church, and I had several opportunities to teach and preach for the two Sundays we were there. Several of the men are able to translate, so when we move there we will have bilingual services until I have a good grasp of the language.

Additionally, we spent time familiarizing ourselves with the city layout, the public transportation, and looked at a couple of areas where we could potentially find a home. It's a gorgeous city with a dark history. Since the fall of communism, the country has become economically enriched, but still remains spiritually poor.

If you would, please take the time to prayer for us as we prepare to start deputation. We are in the process of selling our house - please pray that it would sell quickly. We are thankful that we have already been able to schedule some meetings. We will be in Missouri at the beginning of January, Texas and South Oklahoma in February, and Pennsylvania in March. Please pray for us as our kids make this transition to deputation, that the Lord would direct our steps as we schedule meetings, and that our family would be able to be a light for Christ wherever we find ourselves.
